

Dear JSC/JYL Families,

The JSC Committee is charged with ensuring the best possible experience for all of our soccer players in order to develop a life long love for the game. A little over a year ago we asked you to complete a survey about JSC. We heard loud and clear you liked JSC, but you wanted us to get better. We also have the task of ensuring we are financially responsible as a non-profit organization to deliver that experience while maintaining a balanced budget each year. With those goals in mind, the changing club landscape of soccer in the Triad area, declining numbers in travel soccer in general and JSC specifically, the soccer club committee asked the JYL board for, and was given permission to, revisit discussions with PTFC about joining the umbrella organization with PSA of High Point and KSA of Kernersville for our U13 ages and older.

We are in the early stages of these discussions and wish to give you all the time and opportunity to discuss this in several forums. Members from the JSC Committee, Scott Behe, committee chair and DOC Steve Diamond will be meeting with each team to discuss this in the next week, and we will hold a full club forum in late October.
